The Holocaust in Film Evaluating ANY film:

- 1. Salient (the obvious):
 - a. What year was the film made?
 - b. What history was occurring at that time?
- 2. Contextual:
 - a. What country?
 - b. Who is director or scriptwriter?
 - c. Use of stereotypes?
 - d. Photography?
 - e. Music?
 - f. Casting?
 - g. Use of film / terminology?
 - h. Drama (entertainment or pure antisemitism?)
 - i. Documentary (propaganda or liberation footage?)
 - j. Trivialization?

Types of Holocaust Films:

- 1. Fiction (ex. *The Great Dictator*)
- Documentary (ex. *Triumph of the Will; Shoah:* consists of archival film and still photographs; interviews with witnesses, their families and experts; contemporary film sites where events relating to the Holocaust occurred)
- 3. Contemporary Drama (ex. *Of Pure Blood; Music Box*)
- 4. Costume piece (ex. *The House of Rothschild*)
- 5. Poetic documentary (ex. *Damaged Visions:* avant-garde symbolism)
- 6. Hollywood melodrama (ex. Holocaust; Sophie's Choice)
- 7. Liberation footage (ex. *Night and Fog*)
